Child HeLP can help you with civil (non-criminal) legal problems. Legal Aid serves low-income families in seven counties in southwestern Ohio: Brown, Butler, Clermont, Clinton, Hamilton, Highland, Warren. After you are referred to Child HeLP, Legal Aid will determine if you are eligible for assistance.

Child HeLP is a partnership between Cincinnati Children's and the Legal Aid Society of Greater Cincinnati. When your child's health care provider refers you to Child HeLP, Legal Aid may provide information and advice about your situation or may work with you to address the problems impacting your family's health. Interpreters are available for any language.

Legal Aid services are free.



Rental Housing

- Prevent eviction
- Problems like mold or roaches
- No heat

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Benefits

- Delays or denials in getting benefits you applied for (food stamps, Medicaid, cash assistance, childcare)
- JFS or social security benefits stopped

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School

- Suspension or expulsion
- IEP or 504 plan services

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Family

- Custody
- Divorce
- Enforcement of child support
- Protection Order

If you need help with these or other issues, talk to your child's health care provider about a possible referral to Child HeLP.
